

Cambridge Community Scholarship Application & Checklist

****The Cambridge Community Scholarship Committee offers scholarship grants for college education on an annual basis to assist qualifying young women and men graduating from Cambridge Central School. The grant is based equally on financial need and scholarship. These scholarship grants are restricted to tuition, fees, books, supplies, room and board, or other necessary direct college expenses. The grant money is a one-time gift, used preferably in the first semester of college. All applications received by the due date will be referred to an independent, confidential Selection Committee. This Selection Committee is detached from the Scholarship Committee and will evaluate and rank the applications. The grant recipients will be announced at Awards Night. You must maintain a satisfactory scholastic record while using the scholarship grant. If you are awarded a full scholarship to your school after applying for our grant, your application will become invalid.****

Any incorrect information or failure to fill in or explain why an answer was left blank will invalidate the application.
